Cengiz (pronounced “Jen-ghiz”) Pehlevan is an assistant professor of applied mathematics at Harvard SEAS. His research interests are in theoretical neuroscience and theory of neural computation. Cengiz comes to Harvard SEAS from the Flatiron Institute's Center for Computational Biology (CCB), where he was a research scientist in the neuroscience group. Before CCB, Cengiz was a postdoctoral associate at Janelia Research Campus, and before that a Swartz Fellow at Harvard. Cengiz received a doctorate in physics from Brown University and undergraduate degrees in physics and electrical engineering from Bogazici University, Turkey.
